# Hispanic Language and Culture Diploma



## HISPANIC LANGUAGE AND CULTURE DIPLOMA

The **Hispanic Language and Culture Diploma** is a title unique to the University of Alcalá, taught by expert professors and specialists from the UAH and Alcalingua.

This diploma is geared toward university students who have an interest in enriching their knowledge of Hispanic culture and language, and is offered in three categories:

### HIGHER EDUCATION IN HISPANIC LANGUAGE AND CULTURE DIPLOMA (ANNUAL)

**Dates of course:** September 2013 to June 2014

**Credits:** 60 ECTS **Price:** 4,200 €

### EDUCATION IN HISPANIC LANGUAGE AND CULTURE I DIPLOMA

**Dates of course:** September 2013 to January 2014

**Credits:** 30 ECTS **Price:** 2,100 €

### EDUCATION IN HISPANIC LANGUAGE AND CULTURE II DIPLOMA

**Dates of course:** February to June 2014

**Credits:** 30 ECTS **Price:** 2,100 €

To be eligible for enrolment these courses, the student must possess at least a B1 fluency level of Spanish.

The courses will have a continuous evaluation process, according to the evaluation guidelines set by the UAH, and greater priority will be given to students' daily performance.

Attendance is mandatory and will be controlled by the instructor.

### General Objectives

- Provide a diverse and accurate scope of Hispanic culture, straying from typical stereotypes and common topics
- Understand Hispanic culture as more of a result of the fusion of different cultures
- Establish connection between one's own culture with Hispanic culture
- Improve expressive abilities

## Subjects

The diploma is divided into three categories of subjects:

The **first category** is mandatory and focuses on Spanish language.

The **second category**, composed of optional courses, allows the student to select from the list, two subjects from the first semester and two from the second semester.

Lastly, the **third category** allows the student to take classes along side UAH students from the optional classes from the Department of Philosophy and Letters. In this category, the student must select a subject one class from the first semester and one from the second semester.
