



## Before applying you should find out:

### ▪ At which university to make your application

In order to obtain a place on a University Master's, you must [pre-register](#).  
You must pre-register at the UAH except for the following Masters:

- Accounting, Audit and Capital Markets. [Autonomous University of Madrid](#)
- Auditing. [Instituto de Censores Jurados de Cuentas de España \(ICJCE\)](#)
- Classical Philology. [Complutense University of Madrid](#)

### ▪ Specific admission requirements for each masters programme

Admission requirements for each masters programme may vary in regard of previous degrees required or the evaluation of different types of knowledge. You can find out the specific requirements for each [masters at offer](#).

### ▪ It is vital that you send the required documents

If you do not include the required documents in electronic format when making your application, the programme's academic board will not consider your admission application.

### ▪ Your Admission will only be valid if you formalise your matriculation in the same academic year.

If you had already matriculated in the previous academic year and have not completed the programme of studies, you do not have to formalize the application for that masters in the following academic year.

### ▪ You can apply before obtaining your access degree title.

If that is your case, you may pre-register provided that you request and submit your supporting academic title certificate in the established periods.

### ▪ You can study two programmes at the same time

Should you wish to study two programmes at the same time, you will have to apply for a place on your first-choice programme in the first application period. For your second-choice programme, you will have to apply in the second period and send an [application form](#) to the Vice-rector of Postgraduate and Ongoing Education.
